50/50 Raffle Official Rules

- 1. **ELIGIBILITY.** The NSCD Board of Trustees 50/50 Raffle is only open to entrants who, as of the entry date, are legal residents of the fifty (50) United States and the District of Columbia who are at least eighteen (18) years old. Employees of the National Sports Center for the Disabled (NSCD) and NSCD Board of Trustees and Auxiliary Trustees are not eligible to enter.
- 2. TIMING. The 50/50 Raffle tickets will be sold at all Denver Broncos home games, including pre and post season games.
- 3. **HOW TO PURCHASE.** Tickets can be purchased online at www.nscdraffle.com. Tickets are 10 for \$10, 40 for \$20, 120 for \$50 and 300 for \$100.
- 4. **AGREEMENT TO OFFICIAL RULES AND DECISIONS**. By participating in the Raffle, each entrant fully and unconditionally agrees to be bound by and accepts these Official Rules and the decisions of Sponsor (including, without limitation, decisions regarding eligibility of entries, the selection of entrants and the winner, and the awarding of the prize), which are final and binding in all respects.
- 5. **PRIZE DRAWINGS; ODDS; NOTIFICATION**. The winner will receive 50% of the **NET** proceeds. The winning ticket will be drawn during the 4th quarter of the Denver Bronco home game. The winner need not be present to win and must claim the prize within 30 calendar days from the event conclusion. The winning ticket will be posted at www.nscd.org/events/raffle within 24 hours of the draw. All eligible entries in the raffle received by Sponsor or its designee through the applicable Entry Period will constitute the pool of entries for the drawing.

Sponsor will randomly select a potential winner from among the applicable pool of eligible entries. Odds of winning the 50/50 Raffle depend on the number of eligible entries received by Sponsor during the Entry Period. A selected entrant must comply with all terms and conditions of these Official Rules and winning are contingent upon fulfilling all requirements.

A potential winner must check www.nscd.org/events/raffle for the winning ticket number. Winner need not be present to win in order to claim prize, the potential winner is required to submit winning raffle ticket with raffle ticket number noted to match raffle number drawn in person or electronically to info@nscd.org. If a matching ticket is not presented, the winner is deemed ineligible. If the potential winner is deemed ineligible, fails to return the raffle stub within the specified time, or if the potential winner or his/her Entry is found to be ineligible, or if the potential winner does not comply with the Official Rules, then the potential winner may be disqualified and the winnings will become property of the NSCD. Each winner agrees that he/she will not conduct or participate in any media interview regarding this Raffle or any prize without the express prior written permission of Sponsor.

- 6. **PRIZES.** The prize is 50% of the NET proceeds.
- 7. **PUBLICITY.** Except where prohibited by law, participation in the Raffle constitutes entrants' and winner's consent for Sponsor and its designees to use an entrant's or winner's name, biography, likeness, voice, photographs, videos, opinions, statements, hometown and state for promotional purposes in any manner or media (including, without limitation, on the Internet), worldwide, in perpetuity, and without further notice, payment, attribution, consideration or consent.
- 8. GENERAL CONDITIONS. Sponsor reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to terminate, modify or suspend the Raffle, with approval from the Secretary of State's office to verify that the requested change, termination or suspension meets with the Bingo-Raffle law, if, in Sponsor's opinion, there is any suspected or actual evidence of electronic or non-electronic tampering with any portion of the Raffle, or if viruses, bugs, unauthorized intervention, fraud, technical difficulties, acts of God or failures or any other factor beyond Sponsor's reasonable control corrupt or affect the administration, security, fairness, integrity or proper conduct of the Raffle. In such event, Sponsor reserves the right, in its sole discretion (but does not have any obligation), to award a prize to a winner based on the above judging criteria from among eligible, non-suspect entries received up to the time of the suspected impairment, with approval from the Secretary of State's office to verify that the requested change, termination or suspension meets with the Bingo-Raffle law. Sponsor reserves the right in its sole discretion to disqualify any individual it finds to be tampering with the entry process or the operation of the Raffle or to be acting in violation of these Official Rules or in an unsportsmanlike or disruptive manner. Any attempt by any person to

deliberately damage any website or undermine the legitimate operation of the Raffle is a violation of criminal and civil laws, and, should such an attempt be made, Sponsor reserves the right to seek damages and other remedies from any such person to the fullest extent permitted by law. Sponsor's failure to enforce any term of these Official Rules shall not constitute a waiver of that provision or any other provision of these Official Rules.

- 9. **RELEASE.** By entering, each entrant forever and irrevocably RELEASES, DISCHARGES, INDEMNIFIES AND HOLDS HARMLESS, Sponsor and its parents, subsidiaries, divisions and affiliates; any and all persons and entities responsible for sponsoring, fulfilling, administering, advertising or promoting the Raffle or supplying any prize (collectively, the "Releasees") from and against all losses, claims, damages, liabilities, costs or expenses (collectively, "Losses"), arising in whole or in part, directly or indirectly, from the entrant's entry and/or participation in the Raffle (including, without limitation, by participating in any activities at Winter Park Resort), and/or the entrant's receipt or use of the prize awarded in the Raffle.
- 10. LIMITATIONS OF LIABILITY. Sponsor is not responsible for: (a) incorrect or inaccurate transcription of Entry or entry material information or late, lost, stolen, unintelligible, illegible, damaged, mutilated, altered, incomplete, or misdirected Entries or entry materials, or Entries or entry materials received through impermissible or illegitimate channels, all of which will be disqualified; (b) technical failures of any kind, including but not limited to the malfunctioning of any telephone, computer online systems, computer equipment, website, server provider, network, hardware or software; (c) the unavailability or inaccessibility of any website or service; (d) unauthorized intervention in any part of the entry process or the Raffle; (e) printing, typographical, electronic or human errors which may occur in the offer or administration of the Raffle or the processing of entries; or (f) any injury or damage to persons or property, including but not limited to entrant's computer, which may be caused, directly or indirectly, in whole or in part, from entrant's participation in the Raffle, or from viewing, playing, uploading or downloading any material to or from Sponsor's website(s), regardless of whether the material was prepared by Sponsor or a third party, and regardless of whether the material is connected to Sponsor's website by a hypertext link.
